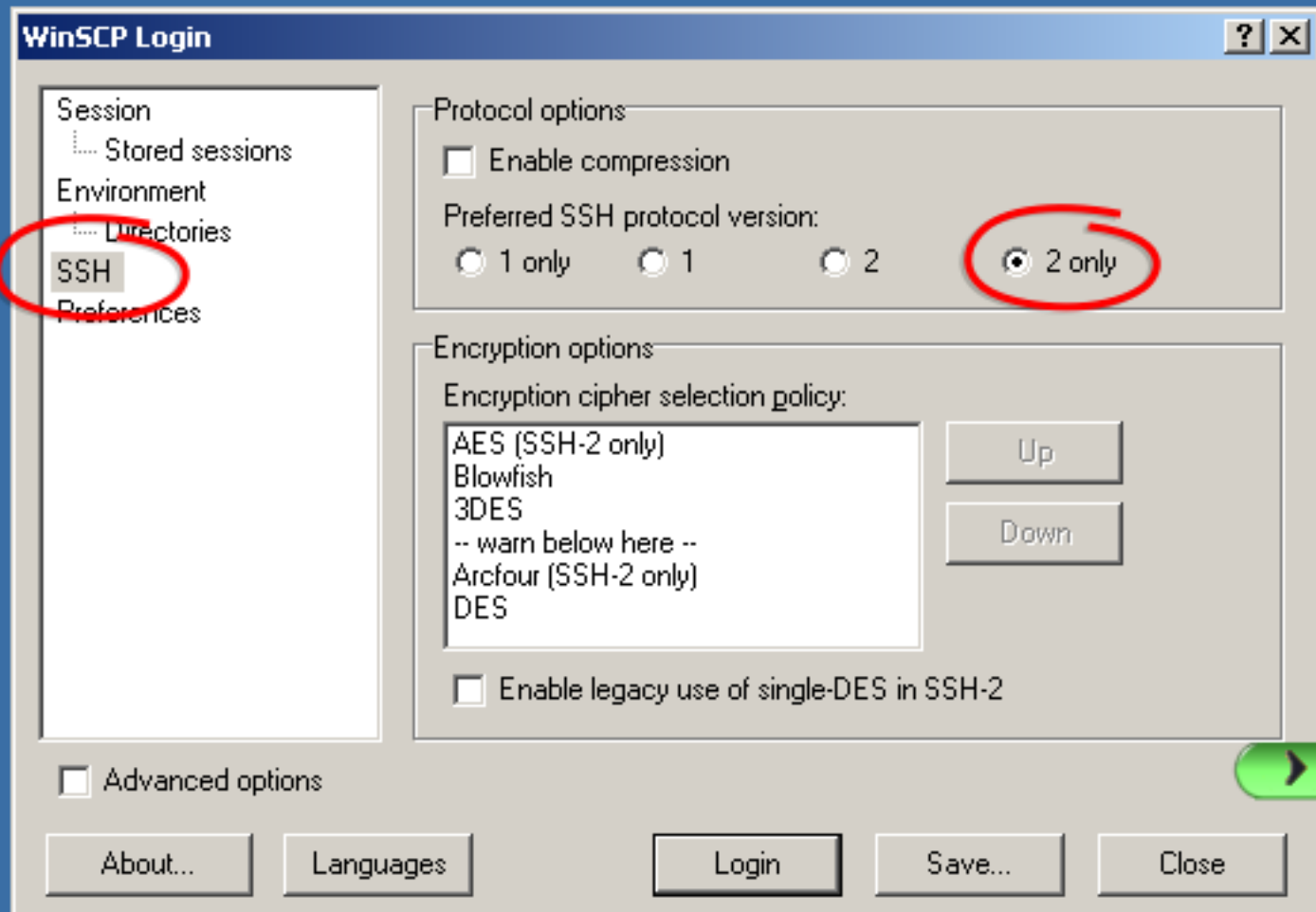

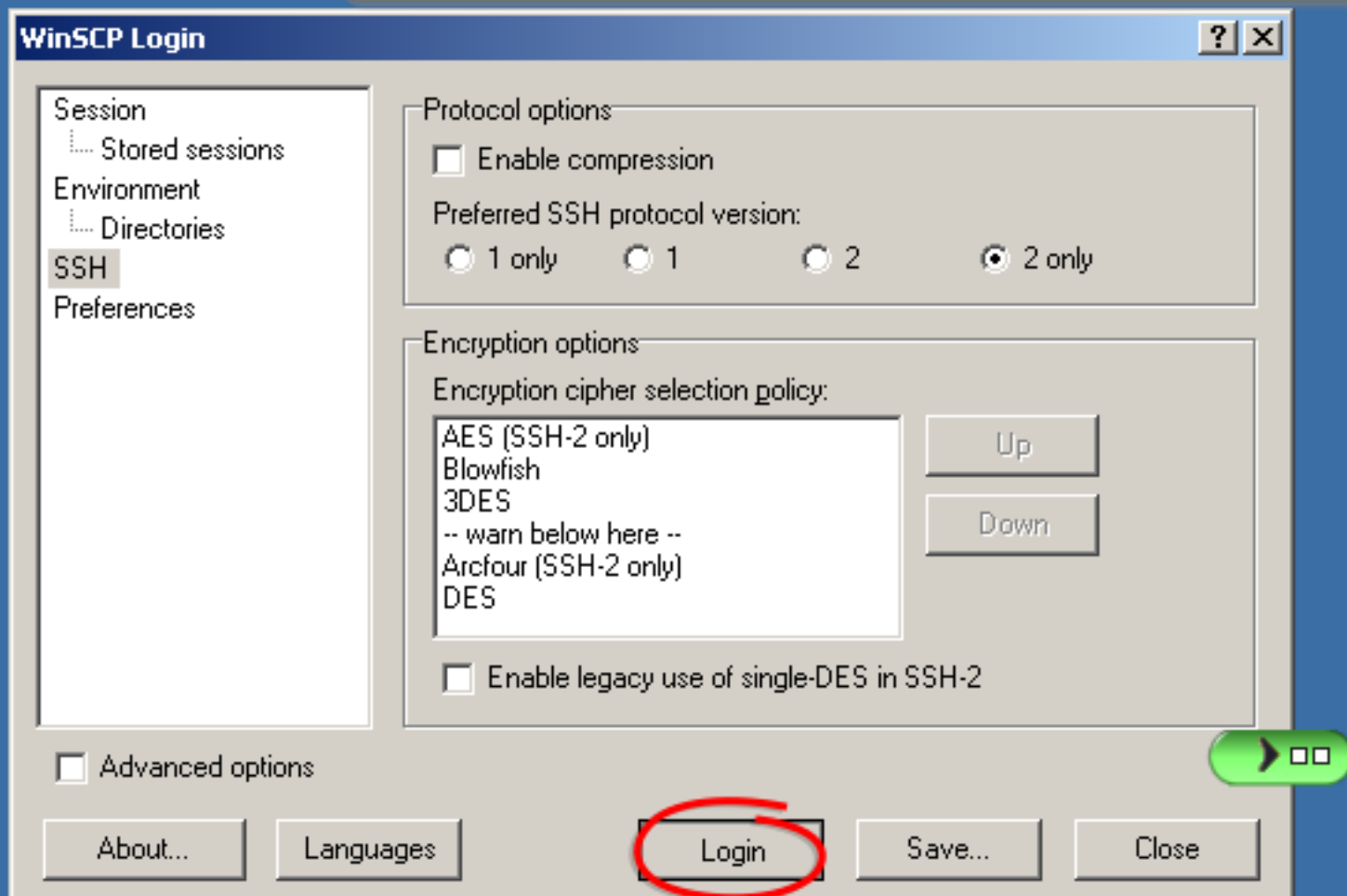


Click on the SSH tab. Be sure to always use SSH2.
